

International Travel Information

Proof of citizenship is required for all international travel. You will be denied boarding without the proper credentials. Don't wait until the last minute, secure these documents now.

Acceptable Proof of Citizenship for US Citizens

Bahamas, Jamaica, Grand Cayman and Mexico

- A valid passport; state issued birth certificate or notarized copy with a government issued picture ID
- Hospital souvenir certificates are not acceptable.
- Voters registration card is not considered adequate proof of citizenship.

Additional Notes:

1. Anyone traveling under a name other than that on their birth certificate must present proof of name change (e.g. marriage licenses, adoption papers, etc.)
2. Children are not exempt and must have proof of citizenship.
3. When using a birth certificate as Proof of Citizenship, a government issued ID is required for travelers 16 years and older.
4. If you are not a US citizen, it is your responsibility to check with your country's consulate as well as the Consulate of the country you plan to visit to determine the necessary documentation.
5. If your international destinations require a passport, it is your responsibility to present it at check-in.
6. Proof of citizenship should always be carried on your person and NOT packed in your luggage.

Parental Consent Form

A parental consent form is required for children under the age of 18 when traveling to Mexico without birth parents. If traveling with one parent, the other parent must sign the consent form. The form is not required, but recommended for other international destinations in similar situations.
